Subject: Implementation of provisions of Homoeopathy Central Council (MSR) Regulations, 2013.

Sr.

This has reference to this Department's letter of even number dated 26th August, 2013, wherein amnesty for non-enforcement of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 was granted for the academic year 2013-14 for all existing Homoeopathy Colleges. Accordingly, CCH was requested to inform all the existing Homoeopathy Medical Colleges and also direct the colleges to ensure compliance of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 and accordingly remove all the shortcomings as required for getting conditional permission for the subsequent academic session 2014-15 as per the provisions of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013.

In light of the visitations done by CCH from 1st January, 2014 onwards, the Central Government during preliminary discussions with CCH had come to the understanding that most of the Homoeopathy Medical Colleges are still not able to comply with the requisite norms as required under the HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 for obtaining conditional permission for the session 2014-15. Further, in absence of enabling provision in the HCC Act, 1973 for granting permissions on annual basis to the existing colleges, the amnesty for non-enforcement of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 is being granted for the academic

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year 2014-15 to all existing Homoeopathy Colleges. Accordingly, Homoeopathy Medical Colleges should also be directed to ensure compliance with HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 and accordingly remove all the provisions of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 as required for getting permission for the academic session 2015-16 as per the provisions of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013.

Subject: Extension of cut-off date of admissions of students in the Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha and Homocopathy (ASU&H) Medical Colleges who have been granted permission by the Central Government in the academic session 2015-16-reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the CCIM's letter No.3014/2003(AY)/6785 to 7028 dated 23.03.2003 and letter No.3-6/2010-Noms dated 19/21.01.2011 for intimating all the concerned institutions and authorities the cut-off date of admissions as 31st October in each academic year for UG and PG courses in Ayurveda, Unani and Siddha (ASU) Medical Colleges.

2. As you are aware that under the provisions of the MSR Regulations for ASU & H colleges, there is no option for conditional permission beyond 2014-15 session and accordingly, the colleges fulfilling full complements of MSR Regulations are to be permitted for a period not exceeding 5 years and failing which the derecognition process is to be started against them. On examining the CCIM's visitation reports' data prima facie for the academic session 2015-16, it was revealed that most of colleges including all Govt. colleges were not fulfilling full norms, hence, a policy decision was taken by the Central Government to extend the conditional permission clause for the academic

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session 2015-16 in view of the larger interest of public and ASU&H education. Thereafter, the Councils started examining the visitation reports and furnishing its recommendation. Meanwhile, all officers and staff of the Ministry got engaged in the assigned work of the prestigious event of First International Day of Yoga and International Conference. Due to the above-mentioned unavoidable circumstances, the processing got delayed.

3. Further, the Ministry has received a number of representations from various State Governments, Universities, Associations, Colleges and students to extend the cut-off date for admissions in UG & PG courses in ASU&H colleges for the academic year 2015-16 to provide reasonable time to all the Colleges and concerned Universities/State Govts./Authorities for completing the admission process for 2015-16 academic session as a one-time measure subject to consideration of all admissions in the extended period by the concerned Universities and authorities involved in admission process for the academic session 2015-16 at par with all other students admitted before 31st October, 2015 and to allow all the admitted students under valid permission of the Central Government to appear in the subsequent examinations at the same time.

4. The Central Council of Indian Medicine and Central Council of Homoeopathy are hereby requested to notify immediately the extension of the cut-off date of admissions in UG and PG courses in the ASU&H colleges till 21st November, 2015 for the academic session 2015-16, as a one-time measure and to circulate it to all concerned colleges, Universities and State Governments and it may also be placed on the Council's website for wider publicity.

I am directed to refer the provisions prescribed under sub regulation 3(4) of HCC(MSR), 2013, wherein, the existing college has to fulfill the minimum standard requirement of infrastructure, teaching & training facilities by 31.12.2014 for consideration of grant of permission for undertaking admission in the coming academic year. Further, as per the provision of sub regulation 3(9) of HCC(MSR), 2013, if the existing colleges fails to achieve full compliance of the requirements as specified in the regulation by 31.12.2014 the college may be stopped for taking admission in existing Courses.

2. In order to verify the compliance of the College, CCH has conducted the inspection of Swasthya, Kalyan Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Center Jai Villa, Narain Singh Road, Near Trimurti Circle, Jaipur-302004., on 15.10.2016 and furnished the recommendation of CCH for granting permission to take admissions during A.Y. 2016-17 in existing Courses, subject to removal of the following deficiencies:- *“Professor not appointed in the departments of Physiology, Pathology and Community Medicine. Reader not appointed in Anatomy, Pharmacy, Surgery and Obs./Gynaecology for UG Course. Teachers or constants of Modern Medicine in various specialties not appointed separately. The USG not available OT and Labor room available but reported to be not functioning Only one librarian assistant has been appointed against the requirement of two”.*

3. In this regard, an opportunity of hearing was given to the college on 15.10.2016. After considering the provisions of HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the CCH, observations of Hearing Committee and policy of the Central Government for granting conditional permission during the session 2016-17, permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Swasthya, Kalyan Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Center Jai Villa, Narain Singh Road, Near Trimurti Circle, Jaipur-302004., for continuing admissions in BHMS course with (100) seats and PG in 03 specialty subjects namely Materia Medica (04 seats), Repertory (04 seats) and Paediatrics (03 seats) for the academic session 2016-17 subject to condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31st December, 2016. which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2017-18:

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- i. The college shall obtain the NABH accreditation for the Hospital within one year and the NAAC accreditation for the College within two years from the issuance of the permission letter and the college shall submit its compliance to this Ministry as well as to the CCH within specified period;
 - ii. All the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations 2013" by 31st December 2016 to get permission for a period not exceeding five years. Failing which, all the existing colleges, which are not able to achieve full compliance of the requirement as specified in these regulations by the 31st December, 2016, shall be denied permission from academic year 2017-18 onwards and action as envisaged under section 19 of the Act shall be initiated against all such colleges apart from rejection of their applications under sections 12A, which have been under consideration by way of conditional permissions or denials"; and
 - iii. All the requirements under the provisions of the HCC Act, 1973 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.



2. Further, the Ministry received the application dated 27.08.2018 to start MD(Hom) course in four subject namely Organon of Medicine & Homoeopathic Philosophy, Homoeopathic Pharmacy, practice of Medicine and Psychiatry with six (06) seats in each subject under 12 A of HCC Act, 1973 for the academic session 2019-20.

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3. CCH inspected the college at LoI stage on 03.01.2019. The executive committee of CCH decided to issue Letter of Intent (LoI) for starting MD(Hom) course in four subject namely Organon of Medicine & Homoeopathic Philosophy (06 seats), Homoeopathic Pharmacy (03 seats), Practice of Medicine (03 seats) and Psychiatry with six (05) seats to the aforesaid college vide its letter dated 04.02.2019.

4. The CCH had inspected the said college on 06.03.2019 for existing UG and PG courses and inspected the college at Letter of Permission (LoP) stage on 24.04.2019 for starting new PG course in 04 subjects and submitted their inspection reports. After examining the inspection report an opportunity of Hearing was given to the college on 31.05.2019.

5. After considering the provision of the HCC Act 1973 and relevant regulations made thereunder, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH and report of the designated hearing Committee of this Ministry; **permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to the Swasthya Kalyan Homeopathic Medical College & research Centre, Jaipur**, for continuing admission in existing BHMS Course with intake capacity of 100 UG seats and MD(Hom) course in the subjects namely Materia Medica and Repertory with 04 seats each and Pediatrics with 03 seats. And for starting new MD(Hom) Courses in the subject namely Organon of Medicine with 06 seats, Pharmacy with 03 seats, Practice of Medicine with 03 seats & Psychiatry with 05 seats for the academic session 2019-20 under 12 A of HCC Act, 1973.

6. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for above said PG courses well in time as per the CCH norms which will be verified and reported by the CCH at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.

7. It is further informed that 15% of the permitted intake capacity of 50 UG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned State Government. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the concerned State Government to admit students as per their rules/reservation policies/norms. **The permission to the college will stand withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.

9. The College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an affidavit duly notarized within one month from date of issue of this permission letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

10. Further, the College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31st December, 2019 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16th January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2020-21.

11. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31st December, 2019 for continuing admissions during the subsequent year. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2020-21 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.

4. *Dr. Swarupananda Sarkar, is MD in Psychiatry in 2014. His date of joining as Reader in Psychiatry is 1/3/19. His previous experience as Lecturer for 4 years is not in concerned subject.*

The counselling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling Authority of State/ UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counselling Authority of that State / UT. 100% Under Graduate of the permitted intake capacity shall be treated as all India quota for Deemed University as they are All India in nature. The Counselling of seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by Central Government.

8. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under. The category wise list of students admitted may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed.
